Raids County Treatment Programs to "Subsidize" State Government Welfare Housing Projects.

Newsom's plan is to have voter approval for a \$6.38 BILLION bond to be paid over 30 yrs. for a total of \$10-12B debt. Your tax money will go towards permanently taking 30% of your current county mental health programs and handing those funds over to state-paid developers through the "Housing First" subsidies program to build so-called "affordable" housing costing \$800-\$1M per unit to build.

It will amend the state constitution and eliminate the right of homeowners to vote against welfare housing to be built in their neighborhoods.

It will subject all the tax funding to the rules of "Housing First" that made it a state law to require all homeless housing to adopt the "Housing First model" which does NOT require the homeless to stop panhandling, drunkenness, trespassing, public defecation drug use or begin mental health therapy in the facilities that house them. They simply get free housing without any requirements to change – all on your dime!

The belief of "Housing First" is that if you provide the homeless with free, permanent housing units, they will then be able to get off drugs and reclaim their mental health. That has never been proven and is false!

Here are some real solutions: enforce all laws relating to loitering, pan-handling, indecency, violence, theft, and trespassing. Use the law to get the homeless into treatment and get to the root of their homelessness. If mental health or substance abuse is their problem, provide mental health counseling and get them into temporary shelter for food and a bed. Require every capable homeless person who receives taxpayer assistance to join a work detail in their community to pick up trash or perform public services. That's Biblical! If you don't work, you don't eat! 2Th 3:10.
